FSJ FINANCIAL UPDATE For the month of April (2024) FSJ income was \$24,834 & the expenses were \$31,983, which means we had a deficit of \$7,149. The overall yearly expenses are 2% under budget, but year to date shows we have a total deficit of \$14,798. Last month, your church council also approved the expenditure for a new chair lift to be installed from the west side entrance of the church down to the basement for restroom access. The cost for this project will be \$6,500+, in which the majority of the funds will come from the Memorial Fund and the remaining cost will come from the Improvement Fund. NO MONEY will be taken from the church's Operating Fund and no additional debt will be incurred. The trustees stated that the project should be completed in about one month. ~Bill Nelson - Treasurer
