<u>JUNE FINANCIAL UPDATE</u>: For the month of June (2024), FSJ income was \$47,816 & the expenses were \$31,945, which means we were positive to our expenses by \$15,871. Thank-you, thank-you church family for your stewardship last month! We not only paid our June expenses but reduced our annual operating deficit by 90% as well. As of July 1st, FSJ has an operating deficit of \$1,709; please continue your stewardship. Note: Through the month of June (6 months (50%) of budget), your church council has spent 48.4% of the approved budget. You can be assured that every dollar is being spent wisely for our Lord & church.
