OCTOBER FINANCIAL UPDATE For the month of October (2024 - 4 Sundays), FSJ income was \$39,368 & the expenses were \$28,664 for a **positive net result of \$10,704!** FSJ year to date finances has a <u>deficit of \$21,957</u>, which is a 32.8% improvement from last month. All expenses were at budget with custodial services down by 75% due to collection of reimbursement from reduction of summer hours.
