OCTOBER FINANCIAL UPDATE For the month of October (2024 - 4 Sundays), FSJ income was \$39,368 & the expenses were \$28,664 for a **positive net result of \$10,704!** FSJ year to date finances has a <u>deficit of \$21,957</u>, which is a 32.8% improvement from last month. All expenses were at budget with custodial services down by 75% due to collection of reimbursement from reduction of summer hours. MONTHLY MINISTRY This month's monthly ministry focus will be the Isaiah 117 House in Lucas County. The Isaiah 117 project exists to reduce trauma on removal day for children who are being placed in the foster care system. The house helps lighten the load for caseworkers and ease transition into foster care by creating a 'home' environment where children on removal day can go instead of an office while caseworkers work on placement. This home provides the comforts of home and lessens the impact. As this is a new ministry spotlight, the donation envelopes will arrive next week.
