**FEBRUARY FINANCES** For the month of February, FSJ operating income was \$22,762 & the expenses were \$38,871; this leaves a deficit of \$16,109 with a YTD deficit of \$23,281. Cost was increased due to a \$5,350 snow/ice invoice and salary invoices catch-up from the first of the year. Utilities were higher due to the cold weather as well.
