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Shining Our Light Together: Friends & Family Dinner Celebrates Community, Discipleship, and the Great “I AM”

“Whatever is meant to happen will.” When we step out in faith to serve our community, these words remind us that the ultimate results rest in God’s hands. Our role as a church family is to be obedient to the calling of discipleship and to build a vibrant community where everyone feels loved, valued, and remembered. On Sunday, August 16th, 2026, First St. John Lutheran Church and Day School experienced a beautiful reflection of this mission at our Friends & Family Fellowship Dinner. 80 members and friends gathered to enjoy one another’s company, renew our commitment to Christian growth, and celebrate our ongoing Outreach efforts. Following a blessing by Pastor Rayl, attendees enjoyed a scrumptious catered dinner from Shorty’s BBQ featuring pulled pork and chicken, baked beans, mac and cheese, coleslaw, cornbread, rolls, gelatin sides, and cake. The room buzzed with wonderful dinner conversation, set to a beautiful recording of Dr. Tony’s music.

A Celebration of Time, Talent, and Inreach

Outreach can often be a difficult ministry to measure by immediate success, as results are rarely instantaneous. However, scripture teaches us the profound value of community and looking after one another. By stepping into the role of loving our neighbors, we become the physical hands and feet of Christ, helping those who may feel overwhelmed, unloved, or unworthy to experience God’s grace in a tangible way. Whether it is providing beautiful Sunday services, visiting the sick, or simply welcoming a neighbor with a friendly smile, our collective personality goes a long way in showing God’s love.

We want to extend a deep sincere thank you to everyone who has given so generously of their time and talent over the last six months to bring our outreach ideas to life. Your willingness to serve has profoundly impacted the hearts of those involved and those served. We especially celebrate the dozen individuals who have stepped up to steer our committee, and the roughly 30 members, and the entire congregation for lifting these efforts up in prayer. Through your incredible generosity, we raised \$1,430 in free-will offerings during the evening.

The Road Ahead: Reaching Our Neighbors

True discipleship is an ongoing journey. Our next step is to continue reaching out to our missed members to ensure everyone is enveloped in God’s care, letting them know: *“God Loves You and You Are Missed”*

At the same time, we are launching an ambitious neighborhood outreach campaign to share this exact message with residents in our surrounding community:

Mid-September: We plan to send out 2,500 postcards to the 43605 and 43616 ZIP codes.

Quarterly Next Year: We will utilize Valpak mailings to reach 20,000 residents each quarter for the next year.

Our ultimate goal is to establish a steady, faithful source of connection for people touched by these mailings to find a home in a community of believers—whether at First St. John or any local church. If even one more soul gets to heaven, every single effort will have been worth it.

We invite everyone to review the “Find Your Place at First St. John” flyers distributed at the dinner. Whether you are a lifelong member or new to our family, please use these flyers to suggest new activities, share Facebook, or check the box to help us contact members we haven’t seen in awhile. Adjusting our methods requires listening to our members, taking action, and refusing to give up on the mission. It is a tall order, but nothing is too difficult for the great “I AM”. Our God is awesome and alive, and our ministry will continue to thrive as we move forward together in faith.

We will return to two services on September 13th at 8:00 am and 10:30 am. Please plan to join us on Sunday at either service.

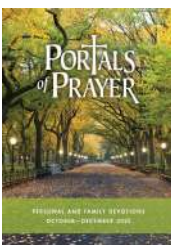

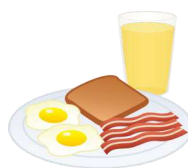
WINSLOW MEMORIAL GOLF WRAP-UP

BORROWING TABLES AND CHAIRS

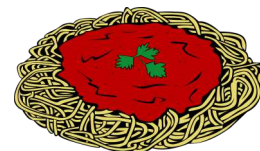

 - receiving blankets, medium weight cotton or flannel, or crocheted or knitted with light weight yarn, between 36" and 52" square
 - cloth diapers, flat fold preferred
 - jacket, sweater, or sweatshirt with a hood, or include baby cap *
 - pairs of socks
 - hand towel, dark color recommended
 - bath size bars of gentle soap equaling 8 to 9 oz., any brand, in original wrapping (no mini or hotel size bars)
 - diaper pins or large safety pins
- * **Clothing sizes can be up to 24 months**
